

## ADMISSION REGULATIONS

### of the Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education «Izhevsk State Medical Academy» of the Ministry of Healthcare of The Russian Federation

#### Foreign citizens and stateless people admission considerations

100. Foreign citizens and stateless people have the right to pursue higher education using budgetary allocations under the international agreements of the Russian Federation, Federal Acts or education quota of foreign citizens and stateless people (hereafter referred to as education quota for foreign citizens) specified by the government of Russia, as well as at the expense of natural and legal persons under the for-profit education service agreements.

101. The student is accepted for studies within the education quota for foreign citizens under the policies of federal executive agency that implements policymaking and legal and regulatory framework in education. The student is accepted for studies within the education quota for foreign citizens by a separate order (orders) of ISMA.

Foreign citizens who are accepted for studies on the basis of international treaties, in addition to the documents specified in clause 40 of the Rules, submit documents confirming their classification as persons specified in the relevant international treaties.

102. Foreign citizens and stateless persons who are compatriots living abroad (hereinafter – compatriots) submit, in addition to the documents specified in paragraph 40 of the Rules, originals or copies of documents provided for in Article 17 of the Federal Law of 24 May 1999 No. 99-FZ “On the State Policy of the Russian Federation in Relation to Compatriots Living Abroad”.

Compatriots are not subject to special rights when enrolling in Specialist’s degree programmes provided in accordance with Federal Law No. 273-FZ, unless otherwise provided for by an international treaty of the Russian Federation 44.

103. When admitting foreign citizens and stateless persons to study in Specialist’s degree programmes under contracts for provision of paid educational services, ISMA independently establishes a list of entrance examinations for foreign citizens and stateless persons (hereinafter – entrance examinations for foreign citizens).

The number of entrance examinations established by ISMA for foreign citizens differs from the number of entrance examinations specified in clause 13 of the Rules, therefore ISMA allocates the number of places for admission based on the results of entrance examinations for foreign citizens and holds a separate competition for these places.

When admitting foreign citizens and stateless persons to study in Specialist’s degree programmes under contracts for provision of paid educational services, ISMA establishes at least two general educational entrance examinations established by order of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation of 30 August 2019 No. 666 “On Approval of the List of Entrance Examinations for Admission to Training in Educational Programmes of Higher Education – Bachelor’s Degree Programmes and Specialist’s Degree Programmes” in the relevant specialty or 26 fields of training. Entrance examinations and enrollment of foreign citizens entering ISMA on a contractual basis are carried out until 1 October 2021. When passing entrance examinations in Russian, the following list of entrance examinations is established: General Medicine (Chemistry, the Russian Language); Pediatrics (Chemistry, the Russian Language); Dentistry (Chemistry, the Russian Language). When passing entrance examinations in English, the following list of entrance examinations is established: General Medicine (Chemistry, Foreign Language (English)); Pediatrics (Chemistry, Foreign Language (English)); Dentistry (Chemistry, Foreign Language (English)).

Foreign citizens and stateless persons may, at their choice, enroll into training programmes based on the results of entrance examinations for foreign citizens, or based on the results of entrance examinations specified in clauses 13–15 of the Rules. In the application for consent to enrollment, applicants indicate in accordance with the results of which competition they wish to be enrolled.

104. When submitting documents for admission, a foreign citizen or a stateless person submits, in accordance with subparagraph 1 of paragraph 40 of the Rules, an original or a copy of an identity document, citizenship, or a document confirming the identity of a foreign citizen in the Russian Federation or the identity of a stateless person in the Russian Federation, in accordance with article 10 of the Federal Law of 25 July 2002 No. 115-FZ “On the Legal Status of Foreign Citizens in the Russian Federation”, as well as:

- a copy of an identification document of the applicant or a foreign citizen identification document valid in the Russian Federation (with a visa or a valid registration certificate if the applicant is currently in the Russian Federation);

- a duly certified translation into Russian of the document of education issued by a foreign state and its supplements (if the latter is provided for by the legislation of the state in which such a document of education was issued);

- a copy of the visa to enter the Russian Federation, if a foreign citizen has arrived to the Russian Federation with an entry visa;

- two 3x4 cm photographs (no headwear, all photographs should have a blank corner on the bottom right);

- a copy of a birth certificate;

- a copy of a migration card;

- a certificate confirming the equivalence of documents issued by foreign states in Rosobrnadzor (Federal Education and Science Supervision Service);

- a certificate of passing the State Testing in the Russian language;

- a medical certificate confirming the absence of medical contraindications for studying in the Russian Federation in the relevant specialty with a special note on the results of the HIV test.

After the documents are verified by ISMA’s International Relations Office the applicant receives an approval certificate and a certificate confirming that the applicant is briefed.

105. Admission of foreign citizens and stateless persons to study in educational programs containing highly classified information is implemented within the quota for education of foreign citizens in compliance with the requirements provided for by the legislation of the Russian Federation on highly classified information.
